Dr. Yeo Oon Hock tendered his resignation as Secretary in May, 1963, as he was leaving the State of Singapore. The Society would like to express its appreciation to Dr. Yeo for the services he rendered to the Society. Dr. Khew Khoon Shin took over the function as Secretary and Treasurer for the Society, with the assistance of Dr. Harold Lai. Dr. T.A. Sinnathuray was co-opted to assist in the secretarial work.

# Membership Drive and Affiliation to the I.F.G.O.

A membership drive was launched to stir up enthusiasm and support for the Society when the Committee took office. The membership at present stands at 66. Arrears in the subscriptions were brought up to date.

Each member of the Society is also an affiliated member of the International Federation of Gynaecologists and Obstetricians. Subscriptions for each member have been paid to date ending on 31st December, 1963. In view of this, our Society is now placed on the International Map and we will be informed of any International function which arises.

#### Meetings and Functions

1963 had been a busy and active year for the Society. Many important personalities in the field of Obstetrics and Gynaecology visited the Society and contributed much to enrich the thoughts and knowledge of Obstetrics and Gynaecology in this region.

In April 1963 Prof. W.G.W. Nixon, M.D., F.R.C.S., F.R.C.O.G., Professor of Obstetrics & Gynaecology, University College Hospital, London, lectured to us and was honoured by a cocktail-barbecue party at the end of the lecture.

In May 1963 the Society was represented by three speakers who contributed papers to the Malayan Medico-Surgical Congress held on 5th May at the Alumni Centre.

Dr. A. P. Chakravorty and Dr. S.S. Ratnam were also present at the Congress.

On 24th May, 1963 a farewell dinner was organised by the Society in honour of the departure of Professor and Mrs. J.L. McKelvey. Prof. McKelvey had been in Singapore as a Visiting Professor in Obstetrics & Gynaecology, University of Singapore, and while he was here he contributed generously and stirred up much enthusiasm in "OBGYN". His departure was felt by many of us who came in contact with this magnetic personality.

In July 1963 two prominent persons lectured to the Society. Prof. E. Page of the University of California lectured to us on "The Evolution of the Human Placenta". He stayed for about four days in Singapore and made personal acquaintances with many of our members and the Staff at the Kandang Kerbau Hospital. At about the same time Sir A.C.H. Bell, the President of the Royal College of Obstetricians & Gynaecolo-

gists visited the Society and lectured to us. A cocktail was organised in his honour at the end of the lecture.

Our next visitor was Prof. W.I.C. Morris of St. Mary's Hospital, Manchester, who delivered stimulating and recent impressions on "Pelvic Measurements" and "Blood Coagulation Defects in Obstetrics". Members of the Society gave a makan kechil party in his honour.
